ABOUT THE 2015 WORLD CHAMPIONSHIP

The Mongolian Air Sports Federation and the Mongolian Aeromodelling Sport Association are pleased to invite you to participate to the 2015 FAI F1 World Championships for Free Flight Model Aircraft (*First Category Event in F1A, F1B, F1C*), which will be held from July 27 to August 3, 2015 in Ulaanbaatar, Mongolia.

Invitation to participate in the 2015 FAI F1 World Championships for Free Flight Model Aircraft is hereby given to every team (three competitors in each class – F1A, F1B, F1C, one team manager, one assistant team manager and one timekeeper) from FAI affiliated World National Aero Club (National AirSport Control Organization), and individual World Champions 2013, as well as Junior World Champions 2014. Supporters, helpers, and spectators are also invited to attend.

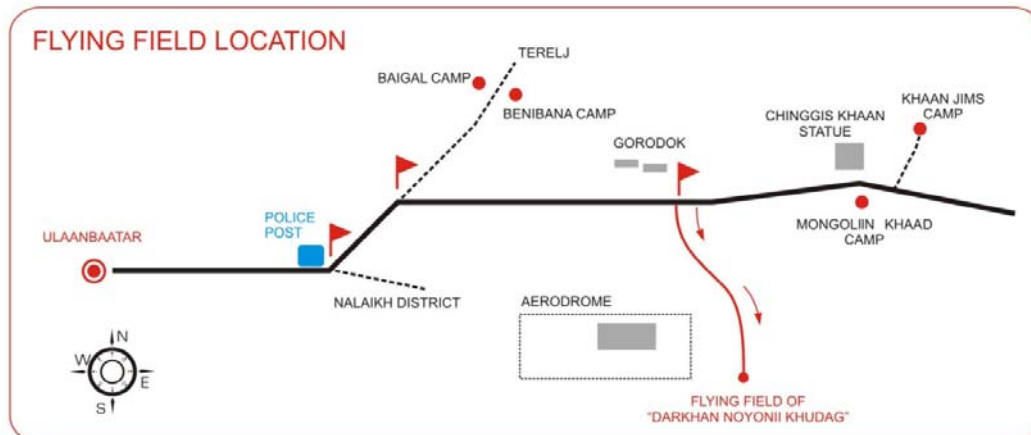
According to the valid FAI Sporting Code, as well as all applicable amendments.

SPORTING LICENCES

Each competitor and team manager must have an FAI Sporting Licence issued by his National Airsport Control valid for 2015 and entered in the FAI Sporting Licence database.

FLYING SITE LOCATION

Flying site – the field of “Darkhan Noyonii Khudag” approximately 50 km to the east from city of Ulaanbaatar, Mongolia. There is an area of at least 7km by 5km of short smooth grass. You can see the flying field on internet by Google-earth software with the pointer 47^o43’59.90” N, 107^o23’34.17” E.

OFFICIAL LANGUAGES

Official languages are English and Mongolian.

HOW TO REACH ULAANBAATAR

- by direct flight from: Germany (Berlin, Frankfurt), Japan (Tokyo, Osaka), China (Beijing, Tainjin, Huhhot), Hong-Kong, Russia (Moscow, Irkutsk, Ulaan-Ude), Korea (Seoul), Singapore, and Turkey (Istanbul);
- by car (from Ulaan-Ude and Irkutsk);
- by train (Beijing, Moscow, Irkutsk, and Ulaan-Ude).

TEAM COMPETITION

Hold in each class of F1A, F1B, and F1C. Each National Federation/ National Aeroclub may enter a team consisting of 3 competitors and a team manager. The team manager may have an assistant. The team flies from one pole.

ATTENTION! While the Competitions, entrance into the Start Line area is allowed ONLY to those persons, who passed the official registration (FAI Jury, Competitors, Team Managers, Coaches, Helpers, Supporter, Timekeepers, Event Organizers) and have the registration

badge. Moreover, all other persons and visitors should be out of approximately 25-30 m zone.

TIMEKEEPERS

Organizers will provide local timekeepers. Each participating country may enter a timekeeper and these timekeepers will be preferably used. The intention to enter a timekeepers should be announced in Entry Form. All these timekeepers should speak basic technical English.

The priority as for selecting timekeepers will be as follows:

- Competitors in F1A, F1B, F1C;
- Competitors in other classes;
- Everyone, who wants to be a timekeeper and has an experience.

Timekeepers will be provided with binoculars, stop-watches, chairs and umbrellas.

RESULTS

The results will be posted on scoreboards at the flying field during the competitions and will be also available on the website.

AWARDS AND PRIZES

FAI medals and diplomas as well as FAI trophies will be awarded to the first three in individual and team classification including a team manager.

Organizer will award trophies to the best three individuals and teams. The following perpetual trophies will be awarded:

PAYMENTS

The protest fee is 35 EUR.

NATIONALFLAG AND ANTHEM

Each country should bring their national flag (approximately 120×150cm) and a CD or MP3 format with their national anthem to the Competitions is requested. These will be returned before your departure.

ACCOMMODATION

Camp hotels are available approximately 5-30 km distances from the flying field. Total number of persons in each hotel is 30-60. The price for the hotels with breakfast is from 30 to 45 EUR per person. The lunch and dinner prices are not included in the hotel costs. List of the hotels is to be announced on the official web site.

Camping will be arranged for participants at the flying site. Refreshments, drinks and food as well as shower on the competitions days will be available at the flying field.

MEAL

Lunch and dinner will be organized on the daily basis at camp restaurants on the flying field and. The price of a hot meal including lunch (~7-8 EUR) and dinner (~6-7 EUR) together at the camp restaurants will be approx. 13-15 EUR. Lunch and dinner prices are not included in the Entry Fee. Other meals except from the meal given on the competition field will be served on the accommodation place.

At the flying field it will be possible to buy refreshments, drinks and food on the competitions days.

Cafe – at the camp site, snack at the flying site.

VISA

Please check if visa is necessary to enter Mongolia from other countries. If you need any papers to support your visa, please let us know. The organizer may send letter of invitation.

It is possible to apply a visa at airport or border to enter Mongolia if there has not Mongolian Embassies' Countries. In this case, please feel free contact us using by the following email as: info@ffmongolia2015.mn.

DOCUMENTS FOR REGISTRATION

- Competitor's FAI Licence valid for 2015;
- A copy of team's banking payment receipt or cash receipt on registration site;
- One national flag approximately 120×150 cm;
- One CD or MP3 format with their national anthem;
- Valid FAI certificates for the models.

ANTI-DOPING

If a competitor has to take any of the substances listed on the WADA Prohibited List for a medical condition, then he must have a Therapeutic Use Exemption from the FAI.

INSURANCE

The Organizer will provide third party insurance cover to all participants for accidents involving injury to others or damage to property according to the host country's legislation. All the participants must have their own health insurance to cover illness and accidents.

MEDICAL TEAM

During the Competitions, a doctor and an emergency will be present at the flying field.

TRANSPORTATION SERVICE

The Organizing Committee will arrange transportation service from the airport to the hotel or other related trip services for participants. Detailed information for transportation including rent-a-car and rent-a-bus will be provided by e-mails (info@ffmongolia2015.mn; accommodation@ffmongolia2015.mn) and web site (www.ffmongolia2015.mn) from the Organizers.

ELECTRICITY

For electrical appliances and charging equipments, electricity in Mongolia operates on 220 Volts (50 Hz).

CURRENCY

1 USD = 1,874 Tugrug – Mongolian Currency – value on November 13, 2015;

1 EUR = 2,373 Tugrug – Mongolian Currency – value on November 13, 2015.

TRAINING

Training is possible whole week before the start of the Competitions, from July 13 to July 26, 2015. All interested countries and competitors must contact the Organizers to confirm their arrival for training.

TOUR

If you will not be on the flying field or have official excursion/tour and sightseeing, we suggest a visit to the places of Mongolian National Parks. The excursion/tour will be arranged in cooperation with local tourist agencies for the participants.

WEATHER

An average temperature while the days of competitions for the last years were: min. 15°C, max. 30°C. The average wind speed approximately 2-9 m/s. Heavy rains are rarely possible. Please take with you a warm sweater and raincoat for any case.

APPLICATIONS

The deadline of official entry form is May 15, 2015, even if the entry fees will be paid later. Applications will be published on web site of the World Championships.

Preliminary entry form is attached in this Bulletin (see Annex). The deadline is January 15, 2015. The form consists only of the name of the country, number of competitors, team managers, and helpers. If you are still in doubts as for the precise names of your team, just write the total number of persons. After that, we will give you Bank Accounts details.

Every team will get a username and a password, for the application, and will be able to access the data and to change them.
