II. GOALS AND OBJECTIVES

- 2.1. Identify the best athletes F3K and F5J aero models class.
- 2.2. To improve the skills and qualification of aero models athletes.
- 2.3. To popularize the sport of radio-controlled gliders.

IV. COMPETITORS

- 4.1. Lithuanian and foreign athletes can participate in the competition.
- 4.2. The competition is held in aero models classes; F3K and F5J.

- 6.3. Local restrictions, such as safety and no-fly zones, will be announced at the airfield before competition.
- 6.4. F3K tasks and groups of participants will be announced before the competition.
- 6.5. 6-8 tours will be flown.
- 6.6. The protest fee is 25 €.
