FIELD

Practice on the field could be possible since Monday August 6th. A specific area will be delimited.

Note: Motorcycles and cars will be prohibited for chasing models during practice and competitions. Only bicycles will be authorised (can be rented on the field).

RULES

The championships will be run according to:

- FAI Sporting Code Section 4 Aeromodelling Volume F1 Free Flight Edition 2023.
- FAI Sporting Code Section 4 Aeromodelling CIAM General Rules Volume Edition 2023.
- FAI Sporting Code General Section and FAI Code of Ethics.

For each class of both F1ABC World Championships and F1ABP Junior European Championships, the reigning World or European Champion has the right (subject to the approval of his NAC) to participate in the championships in that class regardless of whether or not he/she qualifies for the national team. If he/she is not a member of the national team, his/her score will not be considered in the team results.

UAS regulations

According to the UAS regulations applicable in European Union, the UAS operator number of the competitor must be visible on every model.

For competitors from European Union countries, the registration as UAS operator must be normally done by the competitor on its national registration system.

For competitors outside European Union, or competitors within European Union who don't get an UAS operator number, a sticker with the FFAM UAS operator number (FRAd02bpviz5wmpr) will be affixed to the models registered by the competitors concerned. This will permit competitors to fly for the championships without any additional action.

DEADLINES

Deadline for reception of the Final Entry Form is May 31st ,2023.

Entry fees must be paid no later than May 31st ,2023. Entry fees not paid at this deadline may incur a 8 % penalty. After June 30th, entry fees may be refused by the organiser or may incur a 50 % penalty. Entry fees payment of entry fees at the arrival on the site will not be accepted.

Model Aircraft fuel

Fuel for F1C and F1P classes will be provided in accordance with CIAM General Rules C.13.8. We will be able to provide 2 versions: with castor oil or synthetic oil. Please thank you to specify in your final entry which one you want during your competitions.

For practice you can order for 30 euros/5L, to be paid with the final registration.

Timekeeping - For each championship, it is difficult to find sufficient number of timekeepers. Each NAC is requested to provide one or more timekeepers with its national team. In any case, a timekeeper will be mandatored for each competitor participating in a fly-off.
